TERMS & CONDITIONS

- 1. Price to be quoted in Pak Rupees on (FOR) free home delivery basis.
- 2. For competitive bidding, single stage two envelopes bidding procedure will be adopted.
 - (i) The bid shall be comprised on single package containing two separate envelopes, "**Technical Proposal**" as well as "**Financial Proposal**".
 - (ii) The envelopes shall be marked as "**Technical Proposal**" and "**Financial Proposal**" in the bold and legible letters to avoid any confusion.
 - (iii) Initially, only the envelope marked "Technical Proposal" shall be opened.
 - (iv) The envelope marked as "Financial Proposal" shall be retained in the custody of NIE without being opened.
 - (v) After evaluation of Technical proposal, NIE shall publically open the Financial Proposals of the technically accepted bids only. The financial proposals of the bids found technically in-sufficient, shall be returned un-opened to the respective bidders.
- 3. The head-wise cost should be quoted separately in the Financial Proposal. The approved allocation of the project is in Pak Rupee only.
- 4. Bids/offers will be technically evaluated on the basis of the following:
 - (i) Conformity of offered software/ tools with specifications given in this tender.
 - (ii) Source of other Software from USA/ Europe Region, if offered.
 - (iii) Profile of the company.
 - (iv) Similar kind of software supplied to different organizations/ universities/ departments in Pakistan by the supplier/ bidder during last "05" years.
 - (v) Technical staff available for support/ guidance of project employees by the firm/bidder.
 - (vi) Technology/Training offered, if any.
- 5. Preference will be given to Cadence Software from USA/ Europe region. However Software with same or higher specification from other alternate sources of USA/ Europe region can also be considered.
- 6. The license agreement of the Software will be in the name of National Institute of Electronics (NIE), Islamabad.

- 7. Offered Software must be strictly compliant with original requirement.
- 8. The supplier/bidder will certify that offered software/ tools will remain in operation and will be supported by the manufacturer for the quoted license/ support duration starting from the date of operation in NIE. The supplier/ bidder shall also provide **BOND** for providing continuous support in all respect including version upgrade as per quoted license/ support duration.
- 9. Bids offering Software from other regions will be rejected out rightly.
- 10. Bids should be supported with necessary literature/catalogue indicating specifications, make, model, country of original in respect of the offered Software and its allied tools.
- 11. The bids for the Software package/ suite must be for its latest version released by the original manufacturer at that time. The Software version must be clearly stated by the bidder.
- 12. The bidder shall provide technical and operational training/ support for installation/ operation of Software free of cost to as many personnel as NIE may specify.
- 13. The successful bidders shall actively provide installation/commissioning and trial run of the offered software/ tools along with designated NIE officers within "45" days starting from the date of delivery of Software.
- 14. The bidder shall provide details of the documents/ process involved in every stage.
- 15. A detailed schedule for delivery/ online registration/ Registered Software CD from principal abroad must be submitted/ supplied for taken on charge by the Store Section of NIE.
- 16. The firm will keep the Project Director (SCDFC&NE) involved during every stage of the execution of the order/contract.
- 17. Bid should be submitted on the letterhead of firm, which must have complete address, phone numbers, fax number, email address etc.
- 18. Any clarification regarding specifications etc. if required may be obtained from the Project Director (SCDFC&NE) during office hours.
- 19. The bidder must be registered with Income Tax and GST department and provide documentary evidence, failing which bid will not be considered.
- 20. Earnest Money @ 2% (Two percent) of the quoted prices (refundable) must be accompanied with tender in shape of a crossed bank draft/pay order in favour of "Director General NIE".
- 21. The rates quoted should be valid for "180" days from the tender opening date.
- 22. Tender number must be specified on the left corner of the tender envelope.

- 23. List of similar work undertaken during last "05" years supported with documentary evidence and persons involved must be provided with the technical proposal.
- 24. The company profile along with detail of professionals to be deployed on the proposed installation/commissioning should be provided along with technical proposal.
- 25. In case of delay a penalty @ 2% per month of the total order value (without GST, if applicable) will be charged from successful bidder without any notice.
- 26. The successful bidder will have to provide a Performance Guarantee of 5% of order/contract value for satisfactory execution of the work order. The performance guarantee must be valid for a period up to one year after satisfactory supply/installation of the software to NIE.
- 27. All bidders who will participate in tender must provide an affidavit to this effect that they are never be black-listed by any public/government department and that they were never indicated by any court of law on any moral or corruption charges.
- 28. Income Tax and General Sales Tax and any other liable taxes will be deducted from any local bills as per Govt. Rules.
- 29. Any exemption in taxes that is available to NIE being government department must be mentioned. The successful bidder will have to share efforts in obtaining such exemptions, if so required.
- 30. As per Government Policy payment to the firm is subject to the registration of firm name in **Active Tax Payer List of FBR**, otherwise payment will be stopped till the appearance of vendor name in ATL of FBR.
- 31. Last date for the receipt of tenders in the office of the Dy. Director (Procurement) of NIE is <u>March 09, 2021</u> at 11:00 hours. The technical proposal will be opened on the same day at 11:30 hours in the presence of those who wish to be present. Tenders received late will not be considered in any case.
- 32. Director General NIE or Project Director (SCDFC&NE) reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids in parts or as a whole in the light of PPRA Rules.
- 33. In case of any dispute, the decision of DG NIE will be final and cannot be challenged in any court of law.
